

Got Drugs?



PRESCRIPTION DRUG DISPOSAL

- WHERE:** Jefferson County Sheriff's Office
79 Elkins Rd, Port Hadlock, WA
- WHEN:** Monday - Friday 8:00 – 4:00, (Closed County Holidays)

PRESCRIPTION PILLS ONLY, NON-LIQUID

- ⇒ Empty drugs from bottles or other packaging into a small plastic bag. Keep empty packaging until after disposing of the drugs.
- ⇒ Deliver prescription drugs to the Sheriff's Office during regular business hours (above).
- ⇒ Free of charge.

OVER-THE-COUNTER DRUGS, LIQUID MEDICATIONS, VITAMINS and SUPPLEMENTS

- ⇒ Dispose with regular household trash.
- ⇒ Do not dispose of down any toilet, sink or drain.

USED SYRINGES

- ⇒ Collect in an empty soda or cooking oil bottle (#1 PETE) or commercial sharps container. Tighten and securely tape lid when filled to 2 inches from top.
- ⇒ Disposal:
 - ⇒ Trash collection service subscribers: Place secured PETE container inside of opaque bag and dispose with household trash, or
 - ⇒ Solid waste transfer site: (PETE or commercial sharps container) Alert Scale Attendant (fees apply).
