Motor Oil: *Oil filters recycle at HHW, or drain, double-wrap in newspaper and place in your trash.*

Paint: Water-based: Full cans to Waste Not, or Around Again (*see Building Materials*);

Disposal: discard lid, thicken to non-pourable consistency with kitty litter or sawdust and place in trash.

- Oil-based paint and solvents: to HHW.

Plastic Bags: Recycle clean, empty, dry bags at collection bins in QFC, Safeway, Coop. No labels.

Plastic Bottles, Containers: See recycling lists. No deli or clamshell-type plastics, no lids, no drink cups, no coffee pods or take-out containers. No prescription pill bottles.
